This document is the non-binding Expression of Interest Form to obtain transmission rights pertaining to the Champlain Hudson Power Express (CHPE). This completed Expression of Interest Form must be submitted by 5 PM Eastern Time on August 14, 2020. It can either be sent via email to <u>chp-expressism@brattle.com</u> or it can be uploaded through the CHPE Open Solicitation website (<u>www.chpexpressos.com</u>). CHPE, LLC is not requiring parties to execute a confidentiality agreement in order to submit an Expression of Interest Form. However, if a party wishes to execute one, CHPE, LLC will accommodate that request. CHPE, LLC's confidentiality agreement is available upon request.

Expression of Interest Forms will be reviewed by The Brattle Group, the Independent Solicitation Manager (ISM) of the Open Solicitation Process, and CHPE, LLC. Expression of Interest Forms (EOIs) will be evaluated according to the criteria described in the Information Memorandum.¹
